## STATE ROUTE 180 CONNECTOR RAMPS TO NORTHBOUND 99 TO BE CLOSED THIS SUNDAY

- WHAT:** TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TRAFFIC LANE, CONNECTOR RAMPS & OFF-RAMPS TO BE CLOSED FOR HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE & LANDSCAPE OPERATIONS.
- WHEN:** SUNDAY MORNING, FEBRUARY 10<sup>TH</sup> FROM 7:00 A.M. UNTIL 4:00 P.M.  
(NOTE: TIME CHANGE).
- WHERE:** WITHIN THE CITY OF FRESNO; WESTBOUND & EASTBOUND STATE ROUTE (SR) 180 CONNECTOR RAMPS TO NORTHBOUND (NB) SR 99 AND NB 99 #3 TRAVEL LANE (CLOSEST TO THE RIGHT SHOULDER) INCLUDING THE BELMONT AND OLIVE AVENUE OFF-RAMPS.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces maintenance crews will conduct highway pavement repairs and landscape operations this weekend on Sunday, February 10<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. in order to eliminate traffic impacts to motorists during the week. Safety procedures within the project limits will require the full closure of the #3 travel lane. The following connectors, off-ramps and travel lane will be closed beginning at 7:00 a.m:

- **Westbound State Route 180 Connector Ramp to northbound State Route 99**
- **Eastbound State Route 180 Loop Connector Ramp to northbound State Route 99**
- **Northbound State Route 99 - # 3 travel lane (lane near right shoulder). The # 1 (fast lane) and # 2 (middle lane) will remain open to motorists, however, please expect possible delays in this area.**
- **Northbound Belmont Avenue off-ramp**
- **Northbound Olive Avenue off-ramp**

**These scheduled closures will occur, weather permitting. Closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during maintenance.** Caltrans would like to thank the local residents, businesses and commuters for their patience during these closures and reminds you to drive with extra care and allow additional travel time to your commute. Please be alert for Road Maintenance Personnel, adhere to posted signage and please **“Slow for the Cone Zone” at all times.**
