TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURES ON STATE ROUTE 198 SCHEDULED FOR NEXT WEEK

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces scheduled lane closures of the right lane (#2 lane) of westbound and eastbound State Route 198, between Ben Maddox Way and Lovers Lane within the Visalia city limits, in Tulare County. This closure will be necessary to allow Maintenance crews to perform roadway sealing operations.

The following closures are scheduled for Monday, August 13th and Tuesday, August 14th, 2012:

Monday, August 13th, 2012:

Eastbound and Westbound State Route 198, the #2 lane (right lane) between Ben Maddox Way and Lovers Lane will be closed between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. These lane closures will include the on and off ramps for both Ben Maddox and Lovers Lane.

Tuesday, August 14th, 2012:

Eastbound and Westbound State Route 198, the #1 lane (left lane) between Ben Maddox Way and Lovers Lane will be closed between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. On and off ramps will remain open.

During these closures, Eastbound and Westbound State Route 198 will be reduced to one lane between Ben Maddox Way and Lovers Lane. Commuters will experience delays and are encouraged to take alternate routes whenever possible.

Closures may continue for a longer period of time if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during maintenance.
