## **FULL CLOSURE OF HIGHWAY 41 IN KINGS, KERN AND SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTIES SCHEDULED NEXT WEEK**

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) Maintenance Division will be conducting a full highway closure of State Route 41 from State Route 33 in Kings County to the State Route 41/State Route 46 East Interchange in San Luis Obispo County on Tuesday, October 22, 2013. This full closure will be necessary to allow maintenance crews to perform guardrail repair, roadway shoulder improvements, pavement delineation replacements, vegetation control and roadway sweeping operations.

**The following detours will be in effect on Tuesday, October 22, 2013 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (PLEASE SEE ATTACHED DETOUR MAP)**

- **Motorists headed northbound may continue on Highway 46 East to State Route 33 to Highway 41.**
- **Motorists headed southbound on Highway 41 may detour to State Route 33 to Highway 46 East.**

During this Full Closure, traffic will be detoured via State Route 33 to State Route 46. This detour will add an additional 27 miles/minutes to the regular commute for a total of a 50 mile detour. Message boards have been activated on Highway 41 in Kettleman City and Cholame to advise motorists of this closure and detour.

Caltrans Maintenance workers remind you to drive with extra care and allow additional travel time while travelling around the project area. Please pay attention to detour signs and be alert for maintenance vehicles and personnel.


