NIGHTTIME CLOSURES ON MARKS AVENUE SCHEDULED FOR OCTOBER 17-19

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that a section of Marks Avenue in the City of Fresno will close to nighttime thru traffic next week, as part of the 99 Realignment project.

The following closure will be in effect, weather permitting:

- Marks Avenue between Clinton Avenue and Princeton Avenue in the City of Fresno will be closed to nighttime thru traffic on Monday, Oct. 17, Tuesday, Oct. 18, and Wednesday, Oct. 19. These nighttime closures will be in effect from 8 p.m. each night until 5 a.m. the following morning. Flagging personnel will be on-site so that area residents and businesses may travel during these closures.

DETOUR: Motorists wanting to avoid the closure and the construction area may use Princeton Avenue, Shields Avenue, Valentine Avenue and Clinton Avenue.

Caltrans Maintenance workers remind you to drive with extra care and allow additional travel time while travelling in the construction area. Please be alert for Construction Personnel and “Slow for the Cone Zone.”

Commuters are reminded to obey flagging personnel and pay close attention to road construction vehicles and personnel.

Please remember that local businesses in the area will remain open during construction and access to driveways will be maintained, so please continue your patronage.
