### **STATE ROUTE 99 SOUTH BAKERSFIELD 8-LANE WIDENING PROJECT UPDATE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PACHECO ROAD**

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with Security Paving announces the temporary closure of Pacheco Road at the undercrossing of State Route 99 as part of the ongoing State Route 99 South Bakersfield 8-Lane Widening Project in Kern County.

This \$33 million dollar project will convert State Route 99 from a 6-lane highway to an 8-lane highway within the city of Bakersfield from State Route 119 to the Wilson Road Overcrossing. This project will add a 12-foot lane and 10-foot inside shoulder in each direction of State Route 99, separated by a concrete median barrier. Construction is anticipated to be complete in the Summer of 2014.

**The following closure will be in place beginning Wednesday, May 15, 2013:**

**Pacheco Road at the undercrossing of State Route 99 will be closed beginning Wednesday, May 15, 2013 to allow construction crews to widen the undercrossing bridge. This closure will continue for approximately 2 months. Detours will be available to commuters traveling on Pacheco Road.**

Caltrans would like to thank the residents, businesses and commuters for their patience during this improvement project. The public is asked to drive with extra care while traveling through the construction area and please **Slow of the Cone Zone**.
