EMERGENCY LANE CLOSURE ON STATE ROUTE 99 WITHIN THE CITY OF MADERA TO CONTINUE

WHAT: AT&T ISSUED EMERGENCY PERMIT DUE TO WIRE THEFT

WHEN: TONIGHT, WEDNESDAY, JULY 3RD FROM 10:00 P.M. UNTIL 5:00 A.M.
TOMORROW MORNING, JULY 4TH.

WHERE: CITY OF MADERA; NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99/JUST NORTH OF AVENUE 16 OVERCROSSING

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that AT&T has requested to continue to implement an emergency repair project due to recent wire thefts of electrical systems along northbound State Route (SR) 99 just north of Avenue 16 in Madera County tonight beginning at 10:00 p.m. within the northbound lanes. In order to safely implement system repairs, a complete closure of the number two lane (closest to the shoulder) will be required from 10:00 p.m. tonight until 5:00 a.m. tomorrow morning.

Please note: If on-going repairs being conducted by AT&T are unable to be completely restored due to its complexity, an additional night time closure will take place on Thursday, July 4th from 11:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m., Friday, July 5th.

Motorists will experience delays within this two lane section of highway during this time and are advised to use an alternate route or avoid this area. (Schedule subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances).

Caltrans and AT&T would like to thank the residents and commuters for their patience during this AT&T emergency project. Please drive carefully, merge when directed to do so; watch for repair personnel and adhere to all construction signage at all times.
