LANE AND RAMP CLOSURES ON SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99 THIS WEEKEND IN BAKERSFIELD

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces lane and ramp closures to take place this weekend on State Route (SR) 99 in the city of Bakersfield. Maintenance crews will be conducting striping operations on the southbound lanes and on/off ramps during this time.

The following lane and ramp closures will be in effect:

- **Saturday, October 17th — Southbound SR 99 on-ramps between Olive Drive and White Lane will close intermittently between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. No two on ramps will be closed at the same time; each ramp closure will last for approximately one hour while crews are working. Crews will also be striping the #1 and #2 lanes (left lanes) of southbound 99 between Norris Road and White Lane, this will be a moving lane closure.**
- **Sunday, October 18th — Southbound SR 99 off-ramps between Olive Drive and White Lane will close intermittently between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. No two on ramps will be closed at the same time; each ramp closure will last for approximately one hour while crews are working. Crews will also be striping the #3 and #4 lanes (right lanes) of southbound 99 between Norris Road and White Lane, this will be a moving lane closure.**

Closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during road construction procedures. Motorists are encouraged to avoid this area during project work hours and use alternate routes if possible. Portable message signage will be in place advising motorists of the maintenance operations and possible delays.
