## CALTRANS ANNOUNCES CONNECTOR CLOSURE IN KERN COUNTY

**WHAT:** MAINTENANCE EMERGENCY GUARDRAIL REPAIR  
**WHEN:** SUNDAY MORNING, AUGUST 3<sup>RD</sup> FROM 7:00 A.M. UNTIL 2:00 P.M.  
**WHERE:** KERN COUNTY; NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99/ I-5 CONNECTOR RAMP

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces maintenance crews will repair damaged guardrail at the northbound State Route (SR) 99 to I-5 connector this Sunday, August 3<sup>rd</sup> as part of an emergency repair project.

In order to safely implement this project and to reduce commuter impacts to motorists during the week, motorists will be directed to continue along northbound SR 99 to westbound SR 166 then access northbound I-5, which is approximately a 1 ½ mile detour.

**This emergency closure is subject to change due to early completion of project, weather or any unforeseen circumstances that may occur during maintenance operations.**

Portable message signage will be in place advising motorists of the closures. Motorists are advised to watch for highway workers and to adhere to all closure signage.
