CALTRANS ADVISES CLOSURES ALONG STATE ROUTE 99 NEAR SELMA FOR SLAB REPAIRS

WHAT: SLAB REPAIR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT ALONG NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE (SR) 99 REQUIRES LANE AND RAMP CLOSURES TONIGHT.

WHEN: TONIGHT, FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 13TH, 9:00 P.M. UNTIL 5:00 A.M. SATURDAY MORNING.

WHERE: CITY OF SELMA, NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99 JUST NORTH OF FLORAL AVENUE.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces maintenance personnel will conduct slab repair operations within the **Northbound (NB)** number two (middle) and three (slow) lanes of State Route (SR) 99 beginning tonight at 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. tomorrow morning. In order to safely complete this project, the right shoulder within the project limits will also be closed to motorists. **(Schedule or specific lane and/or ramp closures are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances which may occur during maintenance operations.)**

The following on/off ramps will be closed in order to safely implement these improvements along SR99:

- **Second Street on-ramp to northbound SR 99**
- **Floral northbound SR99 off-ramp**
- **Highland Avenue to northbound SR 99 loop on-ramp**
- **Eastbound Floral Avenue connector to northbound SR 99**

Traffic delays may occur along northbound SR99 during this time frame; therefore, motorists are encouraged to avoid the area or use an alternate route whenever possible.

Portable changeable message signs (PCMS) will be activated south of the project limits notifying motorists of lane and ramp closures in order for motorists to merge accordingly.

Caltrans would like to thank motorists for their patience during this improvement project. The public is reminded to be alert for Caltrans personnel and to merge when directed to do so. The safety of our motorists' and work crew personnel is most important, therefore, please stay work zone alert and "**Slow for the Cone Zone**" in all Construction and Maintenance Zones at all times.
