


Caltrans District 9 Bicycle Guide

SR 168

Description:

State Route 168 is composed of two distinct alignments which are separated by a 15 mile gap along US 395. The western alignment begins at Lake Sabrina and exits out of Bishop Creek Canyon where it drops 5,000 feet in elevation until junctioning with US 395 in the City of Bishop. The eastern alignment begins at its junction with US 395 in the town of Big Pine and climbs back up 3,000 feet via a mountainous grade with winding road geometry. It eventually terminates at a junction with SR 266 near the State Border. There is light traffic on SR 168 excluding the urban segment that travels through the City of Bishop. The majority of the route functions as a 2-lane conventional road with narrow shoulders except for the segment passing through Bishop which functions as a 4-lane conventional road as well as a 2-lane road with a two-way left turn lane.
