Pavement Overlay Project on US Hwy 395 & US Hwy 6 throughout the Summer

Inyo County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is beginning a project to place Hot-Mix Asphalt Overlay (HMA) on the existing pavement of US Hwy 395 north of Lone Pine, Ca, north of Independence, CA and on US Hwy 6 in Chalfant Valley. The contractor for this \$5,315,960 project is W. Jaxon Baker, Inc. from Redding, Ca.

HMA overlays are one of the most cost effective, efficient and versatile pavement preservation options available. The benefits include additional structural capacity, enhanced skid resistance, reduced noise levels and improved ride, drainage and aesthetics. Overlays can be placed in varying thickness, allowing the engineer flexibility to design according to the needs of the roadway.

Work is scheduled to begin on Monday, June 3rd, 2013 and should be completed by the end of August 2013.

The traveling public is advised that during daylight hours, there will be various lane closures with flaggers guiding traffic. Anticipated delays are less than 20 minutes.

For the safety of the construction crew and motorists, please be attentive to closures, slow for the cone zone, and move over one lane where possible.
