**What:** Roadway Preservation  
**When:** August 5 – 13, 2013  
**Where:** State Route 58

**Kern County** - Crews will be placing a cold mix overlay on entrance and exit ramps on SR 58 between Mojave and Boron as per the following schedule. Detour signs will be visible for the traveling public.

8/5/13 Monday – Eastbound Clay Mine Road, Exit 188 off ramp. Detour: Eastbound SR 58-20 Mule Team Rod, Exit 193, enter westbound SR 58 and exit Clay Mine Road. 6 mile detour.

8/7/13 Wednesday - Eastbound Clay Mine Road on ramp. Detour: Westbound SR 58-Exit 186 Edwards AFB, enter eastbound SR 58 and exit Clay Mine Road. 8 mile detour.

8/8/13 Thursday - Eastbound exit 193 – 20 Mule Team Road off ramp. Detour: Eastbound SR 58-Exit 194 Gephart Road, enter westbound SR 58 and exit 20 Mule Team Road. 3 mile detour.

8/10/13 Saturday - Eastbound exit 186 Edwards AFB off ramp. Detour: Eastbound SR 58-Exit 188 Clay Mine Road, enter westbound SR 58 and exit Edwards AFB. 5 mile detour.

8/11/13 Sunday - Eastbound Edwards AFB on ramp. Detour: Westbound SR 58 use California City intersection, turn around and enter eastbound 58. 4 mile detour.





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8/12/13 Monday - Eastbound exit 196 Borax off ramp. Detour: Eastbound SR 58-Exit 199 Boron Avenue, enter westbound SR 58 and exit Borax road. 6 mile detour.

8/13/13 Tuesday - Eastbound Borax on ramp. Detour: Westbound SR 58-Exit 194 Gephart Road, enter eastbound SR 58. 4 mile detour.

The purpose of placing an overlay on the roadway is to extend the pavement life, improve ride quality and increase safety.

For the safety of the construction crew and motorists, please be attentive to closures, slow for the cone zone, and move over one lane where possible.

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
