### **Main Meeting Location:**

The building is on the south side of Capitol Mall between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Streets in downtown Sacramento.

Building security is similar to airport screening. ***Do not bring camera phones*** or any other device that can take a picture - they're not allowed in the building. The meeting room is on the ground floor.

Parking is available in downtown garages, but transit/airport shuttle use is advised. On-street parking is extremely limited, and has 1-2 hour time limits that are aggressively enforced. For more information about public parking lots and garages see [Sacramento downtown parking](#) web site and [map](#). In addition to the City-operated parking shown at that site, there is a State General Services garage with some public spaces on the west side of 10<sup>th</sup> Street between O and P Streets – all-day parking can exceed \$20.

[Sacramento International Airport \(SMF\)](#) is about 20 minutes away. Yolo Transit operates an hourly [bus between the airport and downtown Sacramento](#) that stops about 4 blocks away. The [Sacramento Valley Amtrak station](#) is about a 10-minute walk from the meeting site with [Capitol Corridor](#), [San Joaquin](#), and [long-distance](#) service. [Sacramento Regional Transit](#) light rail stations are about a block away on 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Streets.

### **Security and Access Information:**

#### **Sacramento – Federal Building Information**

##### **Building Entry**

- ✓ Arrive 15 minutes early to go through security (similar to going through airport security). The metal detector is more sensitive than many similar detectors at the airport.
- ✓ Bring your driver's license or passport. Other building ID cards (such as Caltrans employee ID cards) are not acceptable.
- ✓ Leave restricted items, such as cellular phones with built in cameras, and pocket knives or anything else that could be construed as a weapon, at home or in your vehicle.

##### **Parking**

- ✓ See map linked above or City of Sacramento website: <http://www.sacramentities.com/parking/>.
- ✓ There are also other privately operated or State General Services parking facilities in the area.
- ✓ Off-street parking costs range from \$7 to more than \$20 per day.

##### **Eateries and Snacks**

- ✓ There is a snack bar on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor in the federal building.
- ✓ There is a food court in the Westfield shopping mall (about 3 blocks from the federal building).

Visitors will need to sign in at the security desk on the first floor, then proceed to the elevator bank on the left side to get to the 15th floor. Picture ID may be required. The Central Conference Room (Room 15-236) is located through the double doors leading to the Executive Offices, down the hall on the left hand side. The room can hold about 10 people, so please contact Dick Fahey before coming to make sure there's space. Closest BART station is 19<sup>th</sup> Street Oakland.
