Robert,

I received your letter from December 5, 2014 regarding the water requirements for the micro-surfacing project for SR28 east of Tahoe City to Stateline. The Tahoe City PUD is not the sole water provider in your project area. We can supply you or your contractor with water from the area of Tahoe City east to the Dollar Drive - SR28 intersection. Areas east of Dollar Drive all the way to Stateline will be in the North Tahoe Public Utility Districts water service area. Please contact them at (530) 546-4212 for water needs in that area.

With respect to the project, will the work impact surface features such as sewer manholes and water valve boxes? If it does we generally have entered into specific agreements with Cal Trans for utility adjustments as necessary. Please let me know if this is to be expected.

We are happy to supply water for the Tahoe City to Dollar Drive area of your project. Please instruct your contractor to acquire a temporary construction water permit from us prior to commencing work. Carol Hackbarth in our office will issue the permit. She can be reached at (530) 580-6325. Thanks

Dear Mr. Floyd:

I'm responding to your request for the availability of approximately 30,000 gallons of water from the North Tahoe Public Utility District for the construction project listed above for micro-surfacing Hwy 28 east of Tahoe City from Sierra Terrace Road to Carnelian Woods Avenue and in Kings Beach from 0.1 mile west of Park Lane to the Nevada State line.

The above-requested water will be available under the following conditions. Please see the red highlighted additions to the map you provided.

- The water must be metered at the hydrants for reporting purposes. If the contractor doesn't have a hydrant meter the NTPUD will supply one.
- The hydrant that we would prefer to be used for the west side of construction is on Carnelian Woods Avenue at the cross street of Carnelian Bay Avenue. We request this hydrant for two reasons. 1) It is off the highway and easily accessible. 2) We want to make sure the contractor isn't using water from Fulton Water Company, a small private owned company which is in between the area of Dollar Point and Carnelian Bay.
- The hydrant that we prefer to be used for the east side of construction is on Cove Avenue east of Islet Avenue.
- If the consumption exceeds 30,000 gallons, we will begin charging a rate of \$3.06 per thousand gallons.

Please supply us with the contractor's information once the project is awarded. Also please feel free to contact me with any questions or responses. The North Tahoe Public Utility District looks forward to working with Caltrans with this project.




