Addendum No. 1

Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for CONSTRUCTION ON STATE HIGHWAY IN NEVADA COUNTY FROM 0.2 MILE NORTH OF COMBIE ROAD TO 0.3 MILE SOUTH OF BREWER ROAD.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on Wednesday, May 27, 2009.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Notice to Bidders and Special Provisions.

In the Special Provisions, Section 4, "BEGINNING OF WORK, TIME OF COMPLETION AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES," is revised as attached.

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.01, "ORDER OF WORK," the following paragraph is added after the second paragraph:

"No work shall be performed before April 15, 2010, with exception of tree removal. Tree removal shall not count towards working days."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.045, "COOPERATION," is added as attached.

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.09, "MAINTAINING TRAFFIC," Lane Closure Charts No. 1 and No. 2 are revised as attached.

To Bid book holders:

Inquiries or questions in regard to this addendum must be communicated as a bidder inquiry and must be made as noted in the Notice to Bidders section of the Notice to Bidders and Special Provisions.

Indicate receipt of this addendum by filling in the number of this addendum in the space provided on the signature page of the Bid book.

Submit bids in the Bid book you now possess. Holders who have already mailed their book will be contacted to arrange for the return of their book.

Inform subcontractors and suppliers as necessary.

SECTION 4. BEGINNING OF WORK, TIME OF COMPLETION, AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

The 1st working day is April 15.

Do not start work at the job site, except for measuring controlling field dimensions and locating utilities, until the Engineer approves your submittal for:

1. Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP)

In addition to the above submittals, do not start work at the job site, except for measuring controlling field dimensions and locating utilities, until you submit:

1. Notice of Materials To Be Used.
2. Contingency plan for reopening closures to public traffic.
3. Written statement from the vendor that the order for electrical material has been received and accepted by the vendor. The statement must show the dates that the materials will be shipped.

The Department grants a time extension if a delay is beyond your control and prevents you from starting work at the job site on the 1st working day.

Complete the work within 45 working days.
