At times, it may be necessary to work outside and or travel to assist at a field mechanic's location, or a highway maintenance station. The Heavy Equipment Mechanic must be able to work in these areas in inclement weather, which may include severe cold or heat. At times it may be necessary to assist with the daily operation of the shop, which may include any or all of the duties. At times it will be necessary to make trips to field locations to assess and clearly communicate needed repairs or parts. Job assignments may be subject to travel, rotation, changes of shift, work hours and workdays.

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
