## RECOMMENDATION

I recommend that the following 2010 SHOPP Amendments be approved:

This amendment adds a Capital Preventative Maintenance (CAPM) project on Route 88 in San Joaquin County at a total cost of \$3,693,000. This project is necessary to extend the service life of existing pavement by repairing localized areas and overlaying existing pavement with rubberized asphalt concrete. This project will be funded from the programming capacity provided through the updated 2010 SHOPP Fund Estimate approved April 2010.
