RECOMMENDATION

I recommend that the following 2010 SHOPP Long Lead Amendment be approved:

This amendment adds a Long Lead Permanent Restoration project on Route 140 in Mariposa County at a total cost ranging from \$35,000,000 to \$180,000,000 pending selection of the preferred alternative. This project is necessary to clear slide, repair, and reopen the roadway damaged by the Ferguson Rockslide in 2006. This project will be funded from the programming capacity provided through the updated 2010 SHOPP Fund Estimate approved April 2010.
