**2014 SHOPP AMENDMENTS TO DOCUMENT G-11 FUNDING IN FY 2014/15**

This amendment adds a Major Damage Restoration project on Route 101 in Monterey County at a total capital cost of \$2,640,000. This project is necessary to remove and dispose of 315 diseased eucalyptus trees. The project allocation was funded from the Major Damage Restoration Reservation in the 2014 SHOPP.

Also, install a potable water line to the southbound SRRA, a booster pump, upgraded irrigation equipment, and devices to protect irrigation assets from theft. This work will provide water savings to meet drought conservation goals. The project allocation was funded from the Major Damage Restoration Reservation in the 2014 SHOPP.
