

**INFORMATIONAL REPORT ON DELEGATED ALLOCATIONS FOR  
 TRAFFIC CONGESTION RELIEF (TCR) PROGRAM PROJECTS**

Government Code (GC) Section 14556.5(a) authorizes the California Department of Transportation (Department) to allocate funds from the Traffic Congestion Relief (TCR) Fund, as directed by the California Transportation Commission (Commission), for specific projects, or phases of a project, listed under GC Section 14556.40.

This is the last report for Department delegated allocations under Resolution G-00-23. Future reports will be based on the delegated authority approved in Resolution G-01-27, which became effective on January 1, 2002. Since the December 2001 Commission meeting, the Department has allocated TCR Funds totaling \$60,268,000 for eight projects (see project list following graph), or phases of a project, programmed in the TCR Program. Through December 31, 2001, a total of \$2,371,878,000 for 131 projects have been approved; 116 of those projects have received allocations totaling \$1,067,340,000. The following graph summarizes this information:
