BACKGROUND

This amendment programs \$180,000 in FY 2001-02 from Los Angeles County’s Unprogrammed Share Balance towards a \$440,000 project to purchase electric bikes and scooters to reduce short commute trips.

Providing electric bikes and scooters will reduce the number of short commute automobile trips, and will support local plans by eliminating the need for the construction of additional park-and-ride spaces at park-and-ride lots, reduce congestion and improve air quality. This innovative demonstration project will be managed by the Southern California Regional Rail Authority (SCRRA). It is estimated that the project will result in a reduction of approximately 4,000 vehicle miles per day, consisting of short commute trips.
