Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

ISSUE:

The collateral facilities included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the Commission approve the following Relinquishment Resolutions:

Resolution No. R-3560 – 03-Nev-267,89-KP 0.0/2.9,0.9/1.4 (Request No. 31281-X) – 3 Segments
Relinquishes right of way in the Town of Truckee (Town), between Georgina Drive on State Route 89 and 0.2 mile southeast of Jeorger Road on Brockway Road, consisting of highway right of way superseded by highway constructed on new alignment, reconstructed and relocated town street, and cul-de-sac. The Town, by cooperative agreement dated March 4, 1999, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3561 – 04-Ala-84-PM 23.2/24.4 & R24.6/R29.6 (Request No. 56059) – 2 Segments
Relinquishes right of way in the City of Livermore, consisting of highway right of way superseded by transfer of highway location. The City, by letter dated October 15, 2003, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3562 – 04-Ala-84-PM 24.4/R24.6 (Request No. 56060) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the County of Alameda, consisting of highway right of way superseded by transfer of highway location. The County, by letter dated October 29, 2003, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3563 – 08-SBd-71-PM 0.6/1.0 (Request No. 410S) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the County of San Bernardino, along Serenity Trail, between 0.1 mile northwesterly of Hill Drive and Chino Avenue, consisting of relocated and reconstructed county road and frontage road. The County, by freeway agreement dated August 10, 1992, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired November 12, 2003, without exception.

Resolution No. R-3564 – 08-SBd-395-PM 5.6 (Request No. 428S) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Hesperia, at Phelan Road and Main Street, consisting of relocated and reconstructed city street. The City, by design and construction cooperative agreement dated February 19, 1998, amended by amendment to agreements dated December 30, 1998 and December 21, 2001, and by right of way cooperative agreement dated November 6, 1997, between the City of Hesperia, County of San Bernardino and the State, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired October 29, 2003, without exception.

Resolution No. R-3565 – 08-SBd-395-PM 5.6 (Request No. 429S) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the County of San Bernardino, at Phelan Road and Main Street, consisting of relocated and reconstructed county road. The County, by design and construction cooperative agreement dated February 19, 1998, amended by amendment to agreements dated December 30, 1998 and December 21, 2001, and by right of way cooperative agreement dated November 6, 1997, between the City of Hesperia, County of San Bernardino and the State, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired October 29, 2003, without exception.

Resolution No. R-3566 – 10-Sta-99-PM 7.1/10.6 (Request No. 13899) – 11 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the County of Stanislaus, between Service Road and Faith Home Road, consisting of reconstructed and relocated county roads and frontage roads. The County, by freeway agreements dated March 12, 1970 and June 12, 1990, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State and by Board of Supervisors Action Agenda Summary, dated July 30, 2002, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
