Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

ISSUE:

The legislative deletion and collateral facilities included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation recommends the Commission approve the following Relinquishment Resolutions:

Resolution No. R-3578 – 07-LA-19-PM 12.3/16.6 (Request No. 1225) – 1 Segment
Relinquishes a portion of Route 19 right of way in the City of Pico Rivera, from Telegraph Road to Gallatin Road, under terms and conditions as stated in the cooperative agreement dated January 20, 2004, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 177, Statutes of 2003, which added Section 319 of the Streets and Highways Code.

Resolution No. R-3579 – 07-LA-105-PM R4.7 (Request No. 1171A) – 5 Segments
Relinquishes right of way in the City of Inglewood, from Lemoli Avenue to Crenshaw Boulevard, consisting of reconstructed city streets and cul-de-sacs. The City, by freeway agreement dated December 14, 1982, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired April 28, 1996.
