Subject: **UPDATE ON PROJECTS DELIVERED BUT NOT YET VOTED**

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) accept the attached reports on the status of State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), State Highway Operation and Protection Program and Proposition 1B Bond projects that have been delivered (deemed ready to go).

ISSUE:

Due to financial constraints of the State, the Commission has been unable to allocate funds to allow the implementing agencies to award contracts for transportation projects that have been delivered.

Attachment 1 reflects those projects delivered in Fiscal Year (FY) 2008-09; Attachment 2 reflects those projects delivered thus far in FY 2009-10. Some projects previously listed have been removed (noted in strikethrough) due to proposed allocation or at the request of the implementing agency.

The projects listed are in no particular priority order. Each list is arranged by project category and then by county.

The current value for the projects delivered in FY 2008-09 (Attachment 1) is \$250,297,000; the current value for those projects delivered in FY 2009-10 (Attachment 2) is \$228,532,000, for a combined value of \$478,829,000.
