Dear Chairman Tavaglione and Honorable Commissioners:

The California Native American Heritage Commission (NAHC), hereby, requests the Commission's consideration to remove the above-referenced item from today's 'Consent Calendar' in order for additional environmental review and clearance to take place. The NAHC wishes to determine the exact parameters of the Caltrans 'easement.' We have been unable to obtain that information from Caltrans, Pardee Homes, or Palomar College Community College District. There have been archaeological resources discovered on this road as well as Native American human remains reported to the NAHC by the San Diego County Office of Medical Examiner. Therefore, the NAHC wishes to have clarity as to the location of the Caltrans easement with regard to the aforementioned resources.

The Native American Heritage Commission (NAHC) is the State Trustee Agency, pursuant to California Public Resources Code §21070, designated to protect California's Native American Cultural Resources. The NAHC is appreciative of your consideration.
