Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

ISSUE:

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolutions in the county where the facilities are located, all rights, title and interest of the State in and to the facilities to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agencies identified in the summary. The facilities are safe and drivable. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RESOLUTIONS:

Resolution R-3865 – 03-Gle-32-PM 0.41
(Request No. 035932-X) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Orland along Route 32 at 8th Street, consisting of collateral facilities inadvertently omitted from a previous relinquishment. The City, by letter dated June 7, 2011, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3866 – 04-SCI-85-PM 6.2
(Request No. 56083) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Santa Clara along Route 85 at Alameda Plaza Way, consisting of collateral facilities. The County, by letter dated January 23, 2013, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3867 – 07-LA-14-PM R26.9/R27.1
(Request No. 1244) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Santa Clarita along Route 14 at Newhall Avenue, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by relinquishment agreement dated February 7, 2013, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3868 – 10-SJ-99-PM 22.9
(Request No. 16589) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of San Joaquin along Route 99 at Hammer Lane, consisting of collateral facilities inadvertently omitted from a previous relinquishment. The County, by agreement dated December 6, 2012, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
