PROPOSITION 1B STATE-LOCAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM PROJECTS OFF THE
STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM
RESOLUTION SLP1B-AA-1213-17, AMENDING RESOLUTION SLP1B-A-1213-01**

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) amend Resolution SLP1B-A-1213-01 to rescind \$800,000 in Proposition 1B (Prop 1B) State-Local Partnership Program (SLPP) funds from the Peyton Drive Widening project administered by the City of Chino Hills, and to remove this project from the SLPP program.

BACKGROUND:

On August 22, 2012, the Commission allocated \$800,000 of Prop 1B SLPP bond funds under Resolution SLP1B-A-1213-01 for the Peyton Drive Widening project identified on the attached vote list. The project was allocated but the agency will not be able to award the project due to Right of Way issues.

The necessary changes are reflected in strikethrough and bold on the attached revised vote list.

RESOLUTION:

Be it resolved, that Resolution SLP1B-A-1213-01 is hereby amended to rescind the allocation amount by \$800,000 and to reflect the removal of the Peyton Drive Widening project from Proposition 1B SLPP program.
