RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the California Transportation Commission (Commission) allocate an additional \$55,000 for one State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) project identified below.

ISSUE:

Additional funds are needed for one previously voted project in order to close out the construction contract.

RESOLUTION:


Resolved, that \$55,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2013, Budget Act Item 2660-302-0042 to provide additional funds for the project identified below.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that this request for \$55,000 be approved to allow the Department to close out this project.



PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This project is located on U.S. Route 101 in Mendocino County near Leggett, from 0.5 mile south of Empire Camp Rest Area to Rattlesnake Bridge. Starting on December 19, 2005, and running through the New Year's weekend, a series of heavy storms struck California bringing heavy rain, high winds, mudslides, and flooding. Mendocino County was one of the 34 counties that were covered in the Governor's January 2006 disaster proclamation. The heavy rains saturated roadway slopes and caused damage at three locations. The slope failure at the first location was excavated and rebuilt with light-weight fill, under drains were installed, and metal beam guardrail reconstructed. Slope failures at locations 2 and 3 were repaired with the construction of a rock lined ditch, a retaining wall, and an under drain system.

FUNDING STATUS:

This SHOPP project was originally programmed at \$2,481,000 for construction capital and was voted in January 2011, for \$2,632,000. Two bids were received and the project was awarded for \$3,029,000 in April 2011, using G12 adjustment authority. Construction started in July 2011. The allocation was adjusted by \$66,200 during construction using G-12 adjustment authority to fund unanticipated work, bringing the construction allotment to \$3,095,200. Construction was completed in September 2012, and the contract was accepted in October 2012. An additional \$55,000 in supplemental funds is needed to resolve all remaining claims and close out the construction contract. This request for supplemental funds will result in an overall increase of 1.8 percent over the current allocation.

REASONS FOR COST INCREASE:

During construction, the lightweight fill failed catastrophically and unexpectedly at Location 1. The design of the fill was modified to improve stability and extra work was required to dismantle and reconstruct the lightweight fill.

The Contractor filed a claim in response to the proposed final estimate, requesting an additional \$132,000 for dismantling and rebuilding the lightweight fill and for unanticipated additional repair costs. A claim hearing was held on February 20, 2013, with the Department and Contractor. The Contractor and Department have agreed on a payment of \$55,000 for the resolution of the claim.

An additional \$55,000 in supplemental funds is needed in order to close out this construction contract.

FUNDING OPTIONS:

OPTION A: Approve this request for supplemental funds, as presented above, for \$55,000 to close out the contract.

OPTION B: Deny this request and allow the contractor to pursue contract arbitration. Arbitration may take several months or years with additional compensation for extended interest.

RECOMMENDED OPTION:

The Department recommends that this request for \$55,000, as presented in Option A, above, be approved to allow the close out of the current construction contract.
