Subject: RESCINDING RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY
RESOLUTION CR-150, RESCINDING RESOLUTION C-21067

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) adopt Resolution CR-150, rescinding Resolution of Necessity (Resolution) C-21067. In accordance with statutory requirements, the owner has been advised that the Department is requesting rescission of Resolution C-21067.

ISSUE:

On June 11, 2013, the Commission adopted Resolution C-21067. Resolution C-21067 is now being rescinded because additional right of way requirements have been identified.

BACKGROUND:

Resolution C-21067 was adopted June 11, 2013, authorizing condemnation of temporary easements for construction purposes, permanent aerial easements, and leasehold interests of outdoor advertising company. Resolution C-21067 is rescinded because legal description for the right of way requirements was expanded to call out the structure's footings and provide better description of the easement's purpose since the adoption of the Resolution. Based on above, it is requested that Resolution C-21067 be rescinded at the June 25, 2014 Commission meeting.
