Federal Lump Sum Allocation

National Highway Performance Program (NHPP)	\$ 229,922
Surface Transportation Program (STP)	556,717
Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ)	467,328
Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)	74,000
Discretionary Programs	252,832
	\$ 1,580,799

- The **NHPP** funds locally-administered bridge projects on the National Highway System
- The **STP** preserves and improves the conditions and performance on all Federal-aid highways and public roads

- The **CMAQ** program provides relief to congested roads and provides funding to Regions to meet the Federal Clean Air Act
- The **HSIP** is used to reduce serious traffic-related injuries on all public roads
- **Discretionary Programs** include Demonstration, Discretionary and Emergency Relief non-formula funds to maintain roads and bridges, improve roadway safety and make communities more livable

State Lump Sum Allocation

Surface Transportation Program (STP) Match and Exchange	\$ 57,849
Bridge Inspection	735
Railroad Grade Separations	15,000
Railroad Grade Crossing Maintenance	2,000
Miscellaneous Unassigned Local Programs	3,250
Freeway Service Patrol	25,479
	\$ 104,313

- The **STP Match and Exchange** allow smaller Regions and counties to exchange their federal apportionments of STP for state cash
- **Freeway Service Patrol** is an emergency roadside assistance service to help reduce congestion and motorist delays on highways
- **Other Programs:** Bridge Inspection, Railroad Grade Separations, Railroad Grade Crossing Maintenance, and Miscellaneous Unassigned Local Programs
