Subject: **STIP AMENDMENT 14S-04**

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission approve the requested State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Amendment 14S-04. This item was noticed at the Commission's October 8, 2014 meeting.

ISSUE:

The Department and the Riverside County Transportation Commission propose to amend the 2014 STIP to reprogram \$400,000 Regional Improvement Program (RIP) from Plans, Specifications, and Estimate (Design) to Project Approval and Environmental Document (Environmental) for the B Canyon Wildlife Crossing Corridor project (PPNO 0071E) in Riverside County.

BACKGROUND:

The Environmental phase is currently funded with \$100,000 in RIP funds and \$400,000 in a committed grant from the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW). Since the grant will not be allocated by the CDFW until spring of 2015, it is proposed to reprogram \$400,000 RIP funds from Design to Environmental. This will allow the project to stay on schedule. Once allocated, the CDFW grant will be used to backfill the Design budget.
