STATEWIDE TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT (STE)  
PROGRAM AMENDMENT

Resolution G-01- 16  
Amending Resolution G-00-14

SUMMARY

This amendment deletes one 2000/2001 Fiscal Year Statewide Transportation Enhancement (STE) Program project for \$300,000 for the State Coastal Conservancy (Conservancy) and adds one project for \$300,000 for the Conservancy in the 01/02 Fiscal Year.

RECOMMENDATION

The Department of Transportation recommends that the Conservancy be allowed to exchange the dollars assigned to the Westport Headlands Property for the Hearn Gulch Beach and Headlands Scenic Viewshed Property. It is recommended that Resolution G-01- 16 , amending Resolution G-00-18, be approved. Resolved, that the California Transportation Commission (Commission) revises the 00/01 Fiscal Year STE Program as shown below:

BACKGROUND

The Conservancy requests a change in scope of this project. They purchased the Westport Headlands Property with their own funds. The Conservancy decided to forego the use of STE funds to purchase that property because it located a far superior property, Hearn Gulch Beach Headlands Scenic Viewshed, in which to use the funds. The Conservancy proposes to exchange the \$300,000 of STE funds earmarked for the Westport Headlands Property to purchase the Hearn Gulch Beach and Headlands Scenic Viewshed Property for the same price of \$300,000.
