Dear Ms. Kiser and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, I am transmitting Administrative Modification No. 36 to California's 2008/09-2011/12 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP), which makes minor modifications to the rural, non-MPO portion of the FSTIP. Project EA 2A6900 is currently funded with \$2 million of State Bond Corridor Mobility Improvement Act (CMIA) funds. Funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act) have now been made available for the construction phase of this project. This administrative modification replaces \$2 million of CMIA funds with Recovery Act funds in Fiscal Year 2009/10. There is no change to the total project cost.

This change is submitted as an administrative modification. The change is within the quadrennial element; does not reflect a change in the design concept or scope of the project, or impact financial constraints. Funding is available for this modification. In addition, there are no projects in this Administrative Modification No. 36 that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.

Since administrative modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration and/or Federal Transit Administration approval, this FSTIP modification has been amended into California's 2008/09-2011/12 FSTIP.
