Dear Ms. Kiser and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, I am transmitting Administrative Modification No. 45 to California's 2008/09-2011/12 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP), which makes minor modifications to the rural, non-MPO portion of the FSTIP. These changes are submitted as an administrative modification. The changes are within the quadrennial element; do not reflect a change in the design concept or scope of the project, or impact financial constraints. Funding is available for these modifications. In addition, there are no projects in this Administrative Modification No. 45 that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review. Modifications are made to the following projects:

- ARRA 5311f – Federal Transit Administration (FTA) 5311(f) Grouped Projects.. This change is submitted for information only. There is no change in funding or year of delivery. However, the type of equipment shown on the detailed project listing for Trinity County has been modified and replaces satellite phones with an emergency radio repeater.
- BIKEPED – Bicycle Pedestrian Facilities Grouped Project Listing for Non Attainment Counties. This modification adjusts the year of delivery and funding for several projects located in Nevada County including the Ridge Road, Newtown Road, and Government Center Walkway Connection projects. There is a slight cost increase of \$34,000.
- BIKEPED2 – Bicycle Pedestrian Grouped Project Listing for Attainment and Nonclassified Areas. This modification transfers \$35,000 of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) Regional Transportation Enhancement funds from Mendocino County to Lake County, and removes \$35,000 of local funds from the Lake County project.
- PREVMINT – Preventative Maintenance Title 23, 771.117, Grouped Project Listing. This modification adds the Samoa Blvd. project in Humboldt County as a result of savings in other areas. The Samoa Blvd. project will be funded with \$389,000 of local funds and \$96,000 of ARRA savings from within the grouped project listing.
- SH\_COLRED, SH\_RDWAYP. SHOPP Collision Reduction Grouped Project Listing, SHOPP Roadway Preservation Grouped Project Listing. This modification combines EA 49270 currently in the Collision Reduction grouped project listing with EA 39860 currently in the Roadway

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Preservation grouped project listing to form a new project EA 3986U. The new project is for construction only. The combining of these two projects results in a decrease in construction costs of \$838,000 in the Collision Reduction grouped project listing and a reduction of \$2,843,000 in the Roadway Preservation grouped project listing. There is no change in the scope.

- SH\_COLRED – SHOPP Collision Reduction Grouped Project Listing. Adds project EA 49880 in Humboldt County. This project will be advanced to FY 2010/11 and increases funding by \$1,008,000 of SHOPP Advanced Construction, and \$131,000 of State Cash. The modification also includes project EA 0F210 for information only. This project is located in various counties, including Nevada County. The funding for the project will be included in the Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) for the Sacramento Area Council of Governments as the majority of work will be done within that area.
- SH\_MOBILI - SHOPP Mobility Grouped Projects. Adds project EA 1E460, Lassen County in Fiscal Year (FY) 2010/11. SHOPP Advanced Construction costs are increased by \$562,000 and State Cash is increased by \$73,000.

Since administrative modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration and/or Federal Transit Administration approval, this FSTIP modification has been amended into California's 2008/09-2011/12 FSTIP.
