The California Department of Transportation has completed the review of the following amendment to the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments' (SBCAG) 2008/09-2011/12 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

4	Financial Element <ul style="list-style-type: none">The amendment updates the FTIP financial plan to include estimated revenue for the SBCAG region based on the proposed American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The amendment adds \$33,000,000 in the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) funds and \$8,929,000 in the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funds respectively as revenue in the Fiscal Year 2008/09.

The SBCAG Board Resolution adopting this FTIP amendment certifies that the amendment is financially constrained, and meets the requirements of public involvement procedures adopted by SBCAG.
