The California Department of Transportation has completed the review of San Joaquin Council of Governments (SJCOG) administrative modification number 7 to their 2008/09 – 2011/12 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). SJCOG submitted this change consistent with the Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP) modification procedures. This change does not require Federal Highway Administration or Federal Transit Administration approval. Therefore, it has been incorporated into California's 2009 FSTIP.

Administrative modification #7 changes funds from American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act) – Transportation Enhancement Program to Recovery Act – Regional Surface Transportation Program, increases local share of funds for a one project, single project, City of Escalon, Operating Assistance Project.
