Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

Please accept for your review and approval this technical correction to Administrative Modification #4 to the Tahoe Metropolitan Planning Organizations (TMPO) 2008 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) that was requested from your office in the original letter dated March 13.

This correction simply adjusts the originally submitted state / federal split of 11.47% / 88.53% of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds to a 100% fund exchange replacement between SHOPP and ARRA in the amount of \$29,460,000.

This amendment adds \$29,460,000 in ARRA funds to the El Dorado County Highway 89 Water Quality Improvement Project from Alpine County to Highway 50 (EA 1A841) and reduces by the same amount in the SHOPP Lump Sum fund category for Construction in FY 2008/2009. The total programmed amount of \$387,803,000 has not changed.

Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

Please accept for your review and approval Administrative Modification #4 to the Tahoe Metropolitan Planning Organizations (TMPO) 2008 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). TMPO staff is requesting this change pursuant to Caltrans' request to modify SHOPP Mandate funds with SHOPP American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds.

This modification falls in accordance with California's revised procedures for FTIP Amendments & Administrative Modifications as approved by the Federal Highway Administration on November 17, 2008 and are within the same four year FTIP period. The proposed changes are administrative in nature and will impact neither the regions air quality conformity nor the financial constraint of the FTIP.

This amendment adds \$29,460,000 in SHOPP ARRA funds and reduces by the same amount the SHOPP State Mandate for Construction in FY 2008/2009. A state federal split of 11.47% / 88.53% has been accounted for. The total programmed amount of \$387,803,000 has not changed.
