Dear MPO FTIP Coordinator,

Attached are projects approved by FHWA's Central Federal Lands Highway Division (<http://www.cflhd.gov/>) for FYs 2015/16 – 2018/19. These projects are funded from various Federal Lands Highway Programs. Please program these projects in your [2015 FTIP](#), and also in your [2017 FTIP](#).

Fund type for each project is identified in Column "F", and corresponding CTIPS Fund Type is included below. The total project cost is included in Column "O". Also matching funds, if any, are listed in the Column "N". Based on the "sliding scale" for California, the local match required is 11.47% (88.53% Federal Share) of the total project cost. Projects with the no match funds listed are funded with 100% federal funds.
