Subject: Submittal of the Kern Council of Governments' Administrative Modification No. 8 to the 2013 Federal Transportation Improvement Program

Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

The Kern Council of Governments' Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) policy is to compile administrative modifications that are made on an as needed basis and report to Caltrans, federal transportation agencies, and air quality agencies. Administrative Modification No. 8 to the 2013 FTIP (Modification No. 8) has been included in this report. The Kern COG staff reviewed the requests and has agreed to make administrative revisions to the 2013 FTIP reflecting changes to the projects below:

State Highway Operations and Protection Program (SHOPP) – KER120202

- The State Department of Transportation requests to introduce new Collision Reduction projects into the group listing for existing record KER120202. Kern COG concurs with the request to expedite the appropriate changes as part of Modification No. 8 because: 1) the change in total funding is less than 40%; 2) The project is exempt from conformity per 40 CFR 93.126.; and 3) proposed project changes do not interfere with the timely implementation of any approved TCMs.

Transit Program – KER110802


- The State Department of Transportation requests to introduce a new Job Access Reverse Commute project for CalVans into the group listing for existing record KER110802. Kern COG concurs with the request to expedite the appropriate changes as part of Modification No. 8 because: 1) the change in total funding is less than 40%; 2) The project is exempt from conformity per 40 CFR 93.126.; and 3) proposed project changes do not interfere with the timely implementation of any approved TCMs.

The financial constraint documentation will be updated to reflect changes made by this administrative modification in the next formal amendment.
