The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has completed the review of the following amendment to the Madera County Transportation Commission (MCTC) 2012/13 – 2015/16 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

3	Local and State Elements

- This amendment adds State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) funding to one project in the MCTC region that relies on a previous federally approved air quality conformity analysis.

The MCTC Board Resolution adopting this FTIP amendment certifies that the amendment is financially constrained, does not change air quality conformity, and meets the requirements of public involvement procedures adopted by MCTC.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to me by the Director of Caltrans, I approve MCTC's Amendment Number 3. I also recommend that the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration approve this FTIP amendment for inclusion into California's 2013 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). Approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of projects for federal funding.
