Dear Mr. Hannon and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) transmits Administrative Modification No. 11 to the Rural non-Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) area portion of the California 2013 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). This modification increases the programming capacity by approximately \$1.433 million. The financial plan will be updated to reflect this change in the next formal amendment.

FSTIP Modification #11 amends the following existing projects in the 2013 FSTIP:

1. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0320, Grouped Project Listing for State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) Minor Program – reduces the total funding by \$5.3 million and revises the detailed backup listing.
2. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0079, Grouped Project Listing for Activities that do not lead to Construction – Statewide Bridge Inspection and Management Program – increases total funding by \$4.7 million for Fiscal Years (FYs) 13/14 and 14/15.
3. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0288, Grouped Project Listing for Bike/Pedestrian Facilities (Non Attainment Areas) – increases the total funding by \$12,000 and revises the detailed backup listing.
4. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0361, Grouped Project Listing for FTA 5311(f) Capital Assistance – adds one project on Modoc County for \$110,000 and revises the detailed backup listing.
5. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0029, Grouped Project Listing for Emergency Repair – SHOPP Emergency Response – increases total funding by \$387,000 and revises the detailed backup up listing.

6. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0066, Grouped Project Listing for Safety Improvements – SHOPP Collision Reduction – increases total funding by \$3.062 million and revises the detailed backup up listing.
7. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0134, Grouped Project Listing for Safety Improvements – SHOPP Mandates – reduces total funding by \$1,000 and revises the detailed backup up listing.
8. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0069, Grouped Project Listing for Pavement Resurfacing/Rehab – SHOPP Roadway Preservation – reduces the total funding by \$1.515 million and revises the detailed backup up listing.
9. CTIPS ID 130-0000-1915, Sacramento Street Reconstruction – modifies fund source from state to federal funds. No change in total project cost.

These changes are consistent with the FSTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification Procedures and have no impact on the rural non-MPO financial constraint or air quality conformity. In addition, there are no projects in this administrative modification that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.

Since administrative modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and/or Federal Transit Administration (FTA) approval, these changes have been incorporated into California's 2013 FSTIP.
