Dear Mr. Hannon and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) transmits Administrative Modification No. 1 to the Rural non-Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) portion of the California 2013 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). This modification reduces the programming capacity by approximately \$13.6 million. The financial plan will be updated to reflect this change in the next formal amendment.

FSTIP Modification #1 amends the following projects in the 2013 FSTIP:

1. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0031, Grouped Project Listing for Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction – Highway Bridge Program (HBP) – reduces the total project cost by \$24.3 million in various fiscal years (FY) and revises the backup grouped project list.
2. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0335, BR #26C0042, Old Amador Rd over Rancheria Creek – adds \$288,000 of HBP funds in FY 14/15 for preliminary engineering (PE).
3. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0365, BR #30C0051, Dogtown Rd over Indian Creek – moves right of way (R/W) funds from FY 13/14 to 15/16. No change in total project cost.
4. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0348, BR 32C0016, Lime Kiln Rd, over Curtis Creek – adds \$278,000 of HBP funds in FY 12/13 and 14/15 for PE and R/W.
5. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0350, BR # 32C0066, Big Creek Shaft Rd over Big Creek – adds \$158,000 of HBP funds in FY 13/14 and 15/16 for PE and R/W.
6. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0288, Grouped Project Listing for Bike/Pedestrian Facilities for Non-Attainment Areas – adds \$1.2 million of State Transportation Improvement Program

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(STIP) and Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program funds in various FYs and revises the backup grouped project list.

7. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0065, Grouped Projects for Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction – State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) – adds \$644,000 in FY 14/15 and revises the backup grouped project listing.
8. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0066, Grouped Projects for Safety Improvements – SHOPP Collision Reduction – adds \$7,094,000 in FY 13/14 and revises the backup grouped project listing.
9. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0029, Grouped Projects for Emergency Repair – SHOPP Emergency Response – adds \$561,000 in FY 12/13 and revises the backup grouped project listing.
10. CTIPS ID 230-0000-0134, Grouped Projects for Safety Improvements – SHOPP Mandates – adds \$554,000 in FY 13/14 and revises the backup grouped project listing.

These changes are consistent with the FSTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification Procedures and have no impact on the rural non-MPO financial constraint or air quality conformity. In addition, there are no projects in this administrative modification that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.

Since administrative modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and/or Federal Transit Administration (FTA) approval, these changes have been incorporated into California's 2013 FSTIP.
