Dear Mr. Hannon and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) transmits Administrative Modification No. 37 to the rural non-Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) area portion of the California 2013 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). This modification reduces the programming capacity in the amount of \$3.7 million. The financial plan will be updated to reflect this change in the next formal amendment.

FSTIP Modification #37 amends the following existing projects in the 2013 FSTIP:

**State Element:**

Proj #1: CTIPS ID 130-0000-2529, Segment 2C of the Lake-29 Expressway Project – moves the State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) funding to an existing Grouped Project for SHOPP – Collision Reduction (see project 2).

Proj #2: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0066, Grouped Project for Safety Improvements – SHOPP Collision Reduction – increases the funding by \$3 million for preliminary engineering in FFY 14/15 and revises the detailed backup listing.

These changes are consistent with the FSTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification Procedures and have no impact on the rural non-MPO financial constraint or air quality conformity. In addition, there are no projects in this administrative modification that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.

Since administrative modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and/or Federal Transit Administration (FTA) approval, these changes have been incorporated into California's 2013 FSTIP.
