SUBJECT: SBCAG 2012/13 – 2015/16 FTIP/FSTIP AMENDMENT NO. 1

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have completed our reviews of Amendment No. 1 to the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments' (SBCAG) 2012/13 – 2015/16 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) that was submitted by your letter dated December 20, 2012. The SBCAG Board of Directors adopted Resolution No. 12-30 on November 15, 2012 approving this FTIP modification. As detailed in the enclosure to your letter, this SBCAG FTIP amendment requests to modify two (2) grouped project listings and one (1) individual project listing previously included in SBCAG's FTIP and California's 2012/13 – 2015/16 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP).

The proposed changes to the FSTIP by this amendment is for projects listed in an area within the State of California that is designated as attainment or unclassified for Federal air quality standards. In consequence, these projects are exempt and without the requirement that an air quality conformity determination be made.

Pursuant to the July 15, 2004 *Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)*, between the FHWA – California Division and FTA – Region IX, and based on our review of information submitted with the State's proposed 2012/13 – 2015/16 FSTIP, which includes revenues, proposed project funding information to demonstrate financial constraint, and statewide and metropolitan planning process documentation, we accept this FSTIP modification proposed for the SBCAG region in accordance with the Final Rule on Statewide and Metropolitan Transportation Planning that was published in the February 14, 2007 Federal Register. We have determined that the amended SBCAG FTIP, including Amendment No. 1, is financially constrained as required by the Federal surface transportation programs authorizing legislation and statewide planning, metropolitan planning, and programming regulations. SBCAG's FTIP was developed through a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with the metropolitan transportation planning provisions of 23 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 134 and 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53. Any project or project phase, however, listed in SBCAG's FTIP that is absent from SBCAG's Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) is restrained from inclusion in the FSTIP pursuant to 23 CFR § 450.216(k) and § 450.324(g).




We are approving the 2012/13 – 2015/16 FSTIP with the understanding that the eligibility of individual projects for funding is subject to the applicant's satisfaction of all administrative and statutory requirements. This joint FHWA and FTA approval of the FSTIP is unable to constitute an eligibility determination for the federal funds proposed for obligation on the listed projects.
