Please be advised that the San Joaquin Council of Governments (SJCOG) made changes to the 2013 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). The SJCOG Executive Director has the authority to approve all administrative modifications. The proposed modifications are consistent with the 2011 Regional Transportation Plan (as amended) and Public Participation Plan (as amended) adopted by the SJCOG Board of Directors.

FTIP Administrative Modification #17 amends the existing projects in the 2013 FTIP as follows:

- (1) Grouped Projects for SHOPP Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction (CTIPS #212-0000-0432), add \$2,342,000 in SHOPP AC funds and add one project in FFY 2013/14.

## RECOMMENDATION

### 2012 SHOPP AMENDMENTS TO ALLOW FUNDING IN FY 2013/14 AND BEYOND

This amendment adds a Bridge Major Rehabilitation project on Route 12 in San Joaquin County at a total capital cost of \$2,000,000. This project is necessary to replace bridge bearing pads, joint seals, and approach slabs. This project will be funded from the Bridge Preventative Maintenance Reservation in the 2012 SHOPP.
