The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has completed the review of the following amendment to the San Joaquin Council of Governments' (SJCOG) 2012/13 - 2015/16 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

4	State, Transit, and Local Elements

This amendment adds, deletes, and modifies projects in San Joaquin County. It includes projects with funding from the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program, Federal Transit Administration (FTA) 5307 Program, and Highway Safety Improvement Program.

The SJCOG Board Resolution adopting this FTIP amendment certifies that the amendment is financially constrained, consistent with the adopted conformity analysis, and meets the requirements of public involvement procedures adopted by SJCOG.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to me by the Director of Caltrans, I approve SJCOG's Amendment Number 4. I also recommend that the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and FTA approve this FTIP amendment for inclusion into California's 2013 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). Projects included in this FTIP amendment, in fiscal years not within the four-year cycle of the current FSTIP, are not approved as part of this FTIP amendment and are shown for information only. Approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of project for federal funding.
